These scenes were captured through the lens of Robert Southwick's camera when he sailed around the Australian coast and overseas, as an 18 year old Radio Officer in the Merchant Navy.

The eldest of three children, he studied at the Marconi School of Wireless in Melbourne, graduating as a Radio officer in 1949. With the majority of his wages being sent home, he managed to save and purchase a camera and development equipment to pursue his passion for photography during his many months away from home.

During his leave, back home in Blackburn, Victoria, he would develop the negatives and hang them to dry on a line drawn across his family's farmhouse kitchen. These negatives were carefully stored in the family home, unseen for over 50 years until recently discovered, by Robert's son, Stuart.

The unique Australian character became immediately apparent and worthy of publication.

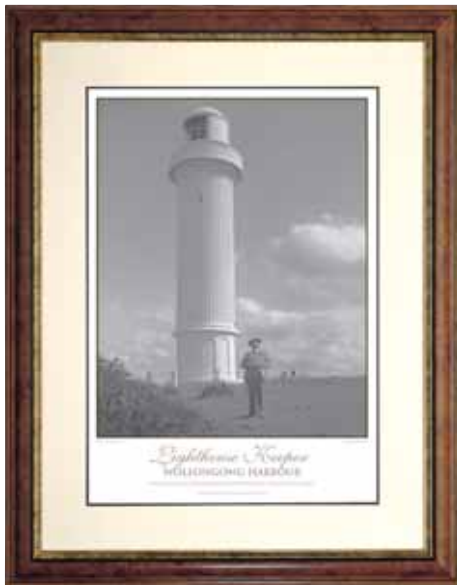

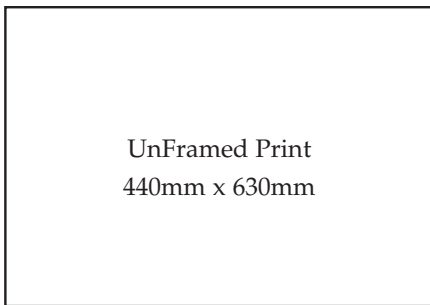
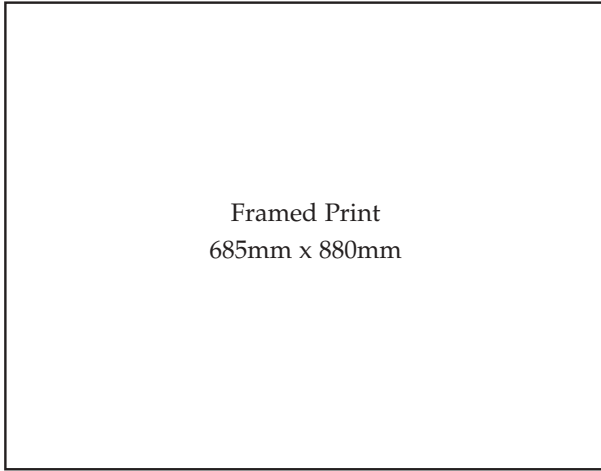
